Elvis Presley is known as the King of Rock and Roll. He was born in Mississippi on January 8, 1935. He received his first guitar in 1946. When Elvis was 12, his family moved to Memphis, Tennessee.

Elvis began a career in music. In 1955, he signed a contract with RCA records. He soon became famous for his music, and he acted in several movies. He continued to sing, act, and give concerts for the rest of his life.

Elvis got married in 1967. He and his wife, Priscilla, had a baby in 1968 and named her Lisa Marie. In 1973, Elvis and Priscilla got divorced, and he never married again. Elvis died of heart failure on August 16, 1977.
